## PREMIUM LAGERS

Characterized by their easy drinkability, lagers work well with or without food. Traditionally light golden in color, these “session” beers typically have mild hop bitterness with little malt aroma.



### STELLA ARTOIS (Belgium)

50cl 5.2% \$8 *draught*  
34cl 5.2% \$7 *bottle*

Europe’s premium lager.  
Brewed with the finest barley & hops.



### STELLA “LEGERE” (Belgium)

34cl 4% \$7 *bottle*

Premium light beer.  
Unmatched in quality & taste.



### BECKS (Germany)

50cl 5.2% \$9 *draught*

Underlying hints of malt sweetness.  
Finish is dry & hoppy.



### BORIS (France)

25cl 5.2% \$6 *bottle*

Pure gold in color.  
Crisp, clean flavor with no aftertaste.



### BUDWEISER (USA)

34cl 5% \$7 *bottle*

Only major brewery to still use the  
“beechwood” aging process.



### AUSTRALIAN MOUNTAIN PEPPER BERRY (Canada)

34cl 5% \$7 *bottle*

Flavored with sundried Aussie blueberries, there is a slight fruit nose, but no fruity taste. Wonderful tinge of black pepper on your tongue, reminiscent of a full-bodied shiraz.



### SAP VAMPIRE MAPLE LAGER (Canada)

34cl 5% \$7 *bottle*

This is a simple, wonderful lager brewed with very distinctive specialty Canadian malts. Flavoured with all natural maple for a subtle yet distinctive flavour.



### KRONENBOURG (France)

34cl 5% \$8 *bottle*

Strong traditional lager given a lengthy maturation period that provides aromas of green leafy hops, malt & floral yeast, along with hints of ripe plums, apricots & honey.

**GOLDEN ALES**

A typical golden ale has an appearance similar to that of a Pilsner beer. Malt character is subdued and the hop profile ranges from spicy to citrus. While some of these beers are at a conventional alcohol content, the most famous are the very strong ones at 8% or greater.



**DELIRIUM TREMENS (Belgium)**

33cl 9% \$10 **bottle**

Distinctive spicy character with sweet finish. Voted "best beer in the world".



**DUVEL (Belgium)**

33cl 9% \$12 **bottle**

Refreshingly easy drinking beer. Stone dry with fragrant, zesty fruit flavor.



**LA FIN DU MONDE (Canada)**

34cl 9% \$7 **bottle**

Subtlety & strength. A chorus of fruit, spice & hop notes create "liquid gold".



**PETRUS BLOND (Belgium)**

33cl 6.6% \$9 **bottle**

Pours to a clear golden orange color with a huge fluffy white head. The nose has aromas of grain, fruit & spice coming through, while the finish is balanced and very clean.

**TRAPPIST ALES**

Authentic Trappist beers are brewed inside a Trappist monastery under the strict control & responsibility of the monastic community. All Trappist beers are bottle conditioned & are widely considered to be the "best of the best" when it comes to Belgian beers. To date, there are only 6 beers in Belgium able to carry the appellation "Trappist" & we proudly serve 4!



**CHIMAY BLUE (Belgium)**

33cl 9% \$13 **bottle**

Floral & yeasty aroma gives way to rich fruit, spice & roasted malt flavors



**ROCHEFORT "6" (Belgium)**

33cl 7.5% \$12 **bottle**

Consistent texture leads to slight spice aroma, intense caramel & hints of raisins. Brewed only once a year, a very unique & exclusive beer



**WESTMALLE DUBBEL (Belgium)**

33cl 6.5% \$12 **bottle**

Pours to a hazy, rich & dark, peaty color. Good carbonation with a fruity, ripe-banana quality.



**WESTMALLE TRIPEL (Belgium)**

33cl 9.5% \$13 **bottle**

Known as the mother of all "triples", pale malts used in brewing help create the high alcohol content without imparting dark color. Soft & creamy with a fruity aroma.

### ABBEY ALES

Most of these beers are of a similar style to that of the Trappist Ales. Originally created in monasteries, these beers are now licensed to be made in major commercial breweries. Some of these beers are spiced, while others simply derive a spicy taste from the yeasts used.



#### LEFFE BLOND (Belgium)

30cl 5.2% \$7 *draught*

World's leading Abbey style beer. Elegant, sweet & soft. Fresh & fruity aroma with a subtle banana finish. Hints of clove & vanilla backed by a caramel aftertaste.



#### TRIPLE KARMELIET (Belgium)

33cl 8.1% \$10 *bottle*

Refined & complex with hints of vanilla & citrus on the nose. Use of 3 different grains; wheat, oats & barley, helps to create this masterpiece. Voted "Worlds Best Ale" at the 2008 World Beer Awards.



#### ST. BERNARDUS ABT 12 (Belgium)

33cl 8% \$11 *bottle*

Dark ivory colored with high fermentation. Fruit forward. Showpiece of the brewery.



#### ST. BERNARDUS TRIPEL (Belgium)

33cl 8% \$9 *bottle*

Flowery fruity taste with a harmonious balance of sweet & sour.



#### AFFLIGEM (Belgium)

33cl 5.2% \$7 *bottle*

Richness in aroma & taste. Chalice glass reflects "sacred" origins.

### PALE ALES

Pale ale is a term used to describe a variety of beers which use ale yeast & predominantly pale malts. It is widely considered to be one of the major beer style groups.



#### KEITHS INDIA PALE ALE (Canada)

50cl 5% \$7 *draught*

Clear, light yellow ale with a small but distinctly fizzy head.



#### BODDINGTON'S PUB ALE (England)

50cl 4.8% \$7 *draught*

With a light golden color, it delivers a full-bodied flavor of hops & malt with a tight creamy head.

**AMBER ALES**

Ranging in color from amber to deep red hues, this style of beer tends to focus on the malts, but hop character can range from low to high. Expect a balanced beer with toasted malt characters & a light fruitiness in most examples. Some of these are spiced while others simply derive a spicy taste from specific yeasts used.



**PAUWEL KWAK** (Belgium)

33cl 9% \$11 *bottle*

Original brewer Pauwel Kwak himself created distinctive glass for coachman drivers during Napoleon era. Mellow malt & spice aroma leads to a fruit attack. Finishes warm reminding you of caramelized banana.



**DE KONINCK** (Belgium)

30cl 5.2% \$7 *draught*

Amber colored top-fermented beer with a lively taste & velvet soft aroma. Served in the famous "Bolleke", the only glass of its kind.



**MAUDITE** (Canada)

34cl 9% \$7 *bottle*

Robust maltiness & spice is counter balanced by an assertive hop finish. A distinct flavor emerges that is cognac-like in complexity.



**DUCHESS**

**de BOURGOGNE** (Belgium)

33cl 6.2% \$12 *bottle*

A traditional Flemish red ale, dubbed the burgundy of Belgium, it is aged in untoasted French oak for 18 months. Look for a taste interplay of chocolate & passionfruit.



**PALM** (Belgium)

33cl 5.2% \$8 *bottle*

Fruity, full beer with a fine bitter sweet balance.



**PUMPHOUSE**

**BLUEBERRY ALE** (Canada)

34cl 5% \$7 *bottle*

Aroma of fresh blueberries with sweet flavours, malty background & sweet fruity aftertaste with hints of pepper. Light-medium bodied with a creamy refreshing head. This blueberry ale is better enjoyed as an aperitif or with dessert.

# DARK & BROWN ALES

## DARK & BROWN ALES

Dark ales are brewed using “dark-roasted” barley malts, giving these beers the characteristics of an old London “Porter” or a traditional “Stout”. In a somewhat comparable style, Brown Ales are brewed using a darker barley malt, creating a flavor that is lightly hopped & fairly mild, often with a nutty taste.



### **PETRUS DUBBEL BROWN (Belgium)**

33cl 6.5% \$10 **bottle**

A top fermented dark beer brewed with pure spring water & carefully selected hops & malts. A beautiful dark beer with subtle & slightly caramelized flavor.



### **ROGUE HAZELNUT BROWN NECTAR (USA)**

65cl 6.2% \$12 **bottle**

A nutty twist to a traditional European Brown Ale. Dark brown in color with a hazelnut aroma & a smooth malty finish.



### **TROIS PISTOLES (Canada)**

34cl 9% \$7 **bottle**

Dark brown color topped with a rich foam mousse. Slight sweetness is enhanced by accents of roasted malt, cocoa, ripe fruit & dark spices with a smooth finish like an old port.



### **CHAMBLY NOIRE (Canada)**

34cl 6.2% \$7 **bottle**

With an opaque black color & beige-colored foam, its roasted malt character is complimented by spicy, mildly smokey notes with a surprisingly clean, dry finish.



### **BROOKLYN BROWN (USA)**

35cl 5.6% \$7 **bottle**

A blend of 6 malts, some of them roasted, give this beer its deep russet-brown color & complex malt flavor. Fruity, smooth & rich with a caramel, chocolate & coffee background.



### **GOLDEN CAROLUS CLASSIC (Belgium)**

33cl 8.5% \$8 **bottle**

Through the combination of caramel & aromatic malts, this “emperor’s beer” combines the warmth of wine & the freshness of beer. A beer which is rich in vitamins & 100% natural, it will charm you with its warm coppery color & its rich bouquet.

**LAMBIC ALES**

Lambic is a very distinctive type of beer brewed only in Belgium. Unlike ales & lagers which are fermented by carefully cultivated strains of yeast, Lambic beer is produced by a spontaneous fermentation process, in which the beer is exposed to wild yeasts that are native to the Senne Valley in Belgium.



**LINDEMANS FRAMBOISE (Belgium)**

75cl 4.5% \$14 **bottle**

Magnificent aroma, delicate palate of raspberries with undertones of fruity acidity; elegant, clean sparkling taste.



**LINDEMANS PECHE (Belgium)**

75cl 4.5% \$14 **bottle**

Glowing golden color, soft & round with a nose of fresh peaches. Crisp, delicious taste that is refreshingly perfect as an aperitif.



**LINDEMANS CASSIS (Belgium)**

75cl 4.5% \$14 **bottle**

Deep reddish-purple color with exceptional aroma, flavor & complexity. Full bodied & soft, while still refreshing.

**SOUR ALES**

Sour ales are all aged in oak to get a rare “sour” finish. Walking the fine line of sweet, tart & dry, these ales create a result unparalleled in thirst quenching satisfaction.



**PETRUS OUD BRUIN (Belgium)**

33cl 5.5% \$10 **bottle**

Deep dark red in color, this beer ripens for 24 months in oak barrels, giving it a vinous, noble taste with slightly sour character.



**PETRUS AGED PALE (Belgium)**

33cl 7.3% \$11 **bottle**

Unblended & made with only pale malts, after 24-30 months in wood, this beer emerges with an oaky aroma. Hints of sherry & fruit lead to a depth of flavors, finishing with low carbonation.

# WITBIER

## WITBIER

Wheat beers are identified as being “white” in several brewing nations. In Belgium they are designated “Witbier” whereas in Germany they are referred to as “Weissbier”.

The designation refers to the pale head formed during fermentation, as well as the fact that these beers are often unfiltered & therefore hazy.



### HOEGAARDEN (Belgium)

50cl 5.2% \$9 draught

33cl 5.2% \$5 draught

The “original” Belgian Witbier. A light, unfiltered wheat beer flavored with coriander seed & curacao orange peel. Easy drinking, a beer for all affairs.



### BLANCHE DE CHAMBLY (Canada)

50cl 5% \$8 draught

34cl 5% \$7 bottle

With an alluring pale golden color, effervescent foam & a subtle bouquet of spice & citrus, it is mildly malty & slightly sweet. Incredibly refreshing, a thirst quencher!



### FRULI (Belgium)

30cl 4% \$7 draught

Wheat beer fermented with 30% pure strawberries. Naturally made with only water, hops, malt, yeast & strawberries.



### ERDINGER (Germany)

50cl 5.2% \$10 draught

A classic Bavarian wheat beer with a sweet, malty flavor & a slight hop bitterness.



### ERDINGER DUNKEL (Germany)

50cl 5.2% \$10 bottle

Rich & smooth, it owes its full bodied flavor & color to the fine hops & roasted malt used in production. Dark color hides a suprisingly light & refreshing taste.



### ST. AMBROISE APRICOT (Canada)

34cl 5% \$7 bottle

A blend of various malts with malted wheat & natural Apricot essence, creates an original tasting beer with a clean fruit nose.



### EPHEMERE (Canada)

34cl 5.5% \$7 bottle

Alluring pale golden color with an effervescent foam creates a mouth watering bouquet of Granny Smith apples & spices. Slightly sweet & tart, completely thirst quenching.

**ROGUE MOM HEFEWEIZEN(USA)**

65cl 5% \$12 *bottle*

The soft texture & pale color come from the use of wheat, coriander, orange peel & special yeast to create a complex beer with the depth of fruit forward flavors.



**WOODY CREEK WHITE (USA)**

35cl 4.8% \$6 *bottle*

A traditional Belgian-style Witbier, brewed with unique ingredients like orange peel & coriander, resulting in a refreshing & slightly citrus flavor.



**CELIS WHITE (USA)**

25cl 5% \$8 *bottle*

The original recipe can be traced back to 1453 in Hoegaarden, Belgium. Once considered a “lost” style of brewing, it was revived by internationally renowned brewmaster Pierre Celis in 1966. When he came to America, Pierre brought his treasured recipe with him & it is now being brewed by the Michigan Brewing Company.

**CIDERS**



**SPIRE MT. APPLE CIDER (USA)**

35cl 5% \$7 *bottle*

The natural sweetness of famed Washinton apples creates this delightful hard cider. Light with a snap of champagne effervescence, each glass is like a bite of crisp liquid apple.



**SPIRE MT. PEAR CIDER (USA)**

35cl 5% \$7 *bottle*

A blend of bartlett, bosc & anjou pears gives this hard cider a gentle zest. Complimented by a soft sparkle, the scent of sunny orchard beckons from every glass.



**SPIRE MT. DARK & DRY CIDER (USA)**

65cl 5% \$12 *bottle*

This refreshing glass of complexity has an assertive tartness that is pleasingly balanced by a hint of molasses & brown sugar. More rounded and intricate than its sister ciders, Dark & Dry will appeal to beer aficionados, wine devotees & cider enthusiasts alike.

**INNIS & GUNN**  
**OAK AGED ALE** (Scotland)

33cl 6.6% \$9 **bottle**  
Created completely by accident, using oak to age beer was unheard of. Flavors imparted by the oak barrels (previously used to mature bourbon) lend an incredible depth of taste. Think vanilla, toffee & orange aromas with a malty lightly oaked palate; soothing & warm in the finish.



**PARADOX WHISKEY CASK**  
**AGED IMPERIAL STOUT** (Scotland)

33cl 10% \$15 **bottle**  
Matured in casks that once housed some of the most prestigious whiskies available today. The distinct flavors of these whiskies are beautifully infused into the beer giving it a unique & unrivalled experience for both beer & whiskey lovers.



**ST. AMBROISE**  
**OATMEAL STOUT** (Canada)

34cl 5% \$7 **bottle**  
Intense black ale with strong hints of espresso & chocolate. Oatmeal contributes body with a long lasting mocha-colored head.



**BROOKLYN BLACK**  
**CHOCOLATE STOUT** (USA)

34cl 10.6% \$8 **bottle**  
The use of 3 mashes to brew each batch helps to achieve a luscious deep dark chocolate flavor. Excellent with chocolate desserts, while also a great accompaniment to strong cheeses.



**GUINNESS STOUT** (Ireland)

50cl 5.2% \$8 **draught**  
Deep dry roasted malt flavor with a refreshing burnt caramel bitterness.



**MENABREA** (Italy)

33cl 4.8% \$7 **bottle**  
A well balanced beer with a marked floral fruitiness coming through from the aromatic yeasts used in its production.
